**TREASURERS' REPORT:** Motion was made by Robert Brady and seconded by David Gindlesperger to approve treasurers' report. Motion carried with all ayes. Victor Seidman abstains

**OLD BUSINESS:** The following were discussed:

- Gym Equipment-discussed purchasing new treadmill. A motion was made to purchase a new treadmill not to exceed \$6000.00 by Victor Seidman and seconded by Robert Brady. Motion passed with all ayes.
- Computers-will get another quote and present at the October meeting
- Ordinance-still having issues
- Standby's discussed-High School \$200.00/game. Pop Warner will be given same pricing for up to 4 hours. A motion was made by Victor Seidman and seconded by Robert Brady to offer our services to Pop Warner at same rate as HS. Roll call-Robert Brady-yes, Victor Seidman-yes and David Gindlesperger-yes

**BUDGET:** Need budgets from EMS, FIRE and LEA

**NEW BUSINESS:** The following items were discussed under new business:

- Drive cams- will look into cost and possibly put in 2016 budget

**CHIEF REPORT:** The following report was given by Chief Rick Byrne:

- FIT test done
- A motion was made by Robert Brady and seconded by Victor Seidman to purchase new filing cabinet not to exceed \$200.00. Motion was passed with all ayes
- Quote of \$4948.00 was received for rescue tool fittings. Will revisit at the October meeting.
- Driver training discussed
- 47 calls 16 different types

**EMS REPORT:** The following report was presented by EMS Chief Jodi Byrne:

- 176 calls 32 refusals 4 aero medicals
- EMS charts SOG- 24 hours to complete charts or will receive disciplinary action. Will further discuss and adopt disciplinary actions at the October meeting.
- Billing- going well with Cornerstone. Collections discussed.
- Defibrillators-need to upgrade. A motion was made by Victor Seidman and seconded by Robert Brady to purchase 3 new for \$4776.26 from Moore Medical. Motion was passed with all ayes. Would like to donate old ones to the Police Department
- Discussed First Aid building issues, new lighting, fixtures, A/C  
\$29,754.78/30%=\$8926.43
- Discussed mutual aid- would like to put on additional man power on the weekends. A motion was made by Robert Brady and seconded by Victor Seidman to do a trial run in September. Motion was passed with all ayes.

**LEA REPORT:** The following report was presented by Joe Paolo:

**FIRE COMPANY:** Don Kernan spoke about the EMT classes a couple of more guys showed an interest. Two guys are currently in fire school, one new junior member starting in September. Oyster Dinner coming up November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015.
